Major participant in public hearing of deadly Lodgepole Sour Gas Blowout which led to stricter regulations for industry.

**1987**

Released People's Guide to Energy Projects and chaired a workshop, "Crimes against the environment," at request of Dept. of Justice.

**1990**

Involved in developing the *Alberta Environmental Protection & Enhancement Act* and the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act*.

**1993**

Appointed by Minister of Environment to provide a list of environmental priorities for the next 20 years.

**1991**

Responded to more than 1000 information requests from Albertans.



**1996**

Drove discussion that led to adoption of conservation easements as a tool for Albertans to protect their land.

Influenced new legislation to regulate feedlots as part of a government-appointed advisory group

Pushed for stronger protection for endangered species under the new *Species at Risk Act*.
